Chaplain's Message

Just this morning I was thinking of our fellow Knights and how much I would like to share my recent trip to Rome. First I'd like my Brother Knights to know that I did indeed accomplish all that I had hoped to do in carrying the special intentions each day to the basilicas and churches in which I served as deacon of the word and altar. My first day in Rome I concelebrated the mass in St. Peter's

Basilica. This mass, in the basilica, at the altar of the chair, was presided by 3 Cardinals, 9 Bishops, 300 Priests and 8 Deacons. It was an ordination Mass for 41 seminarians from the US, Australia and New Zealand. Our diocese has 3 seminarians at the Pontifical College of North America in Rome, one of which was ordained a transitional deacon. This was an awesome honor to be serving in the mass and I bet you can imagine my reaction as I processed into the nave of the basilica with more than a couple thousand people attending! Each day of the 14 day pilgrimage, I served at masses at the following basilicas in Rome; St. Mary Major, St. John Lateran, and St. Mary de Supra of Minerva. Then we went on to Montecassino, San Giovanni Rotondo, Lanciano, Cave of St. Michael the Archangel, Sienna, and then 3 days at Assisi - St. Francis Basilica. While touring the St. Peter's Basilica, at the front entrance, a large plaque from the KofC is prominently displayed. I was in Rome also on Sunday Oct. 13 when Pope Francis consecrated the entire world to Blessed Virgin Mary! Please let our Brother Knights know that intentions were carried to each mass and was prayed for by our priests, deacons and pilgrims each day. Blessings of peace
